Warfarin

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5 mg, Once daily · Evening

USED FOR

Warfarin is used to treat and prevent blood clots, especially in people with an irregular heartbeat or an artificial heart valve.

THINGS TO WATCH FOR

- Easy bruising or signs of bleeding.
- Eat consistent amounts of vitamin K foods (leafy greens) - sudden changes affect the level.
- Tell every prescriber, dentist, and pharmacist before any new medication or procedure.
- Keep up with INR blood draws - the level shifts with food, illness, and other medications.

THREE QUESTIONS WORTH ASKING

1. Is this still the right medicine for me?
2. What should I watch for, and what would tell you it is not working?
3. Should the dose or timing change as I get older?
